Whistler municipal workers are paid 20 to 42 percent less than workers in the Capital Regional District – the only other B.C. community that provides the same source-to-tap water services we provide for you.

Bylaw Officer	\$19.70	\$25.31	\$5.61/hr. less
Clerk	\$18.18	\$21.82	\$3.64/hr. less
Parking Enforcement	\$14.34	\$20.27*	\$5.93/hr. less

* City of Victoria wage as Capital Regional District does not have a parking enforcement officer.
